The Center for Family Safety and Healing fully addresses all aspects of family violence, including child abuse and neglect, teen dating abuse, domestic violence and elder abuse, thanks to an impressive combination of public and private resources. Benefits of their multidisciplinary team approach include:

A one-stop, coordinated response to family violence for individuals and families through partnerships with law enforcement, child protective services, prosecution and a wide range of community resources.

An expanded forum for education, advocacy and ongoing research.

In April of 2011, the Center for Child and Family Advocacy at Nationwide Children's (founded in 2002) and the Columbus Coalition Against Family Violence (founded in 1998) merged into one organization, becoming the Center for Family Safety and Healing. This allowed them to combine the strengths of both organizations to form one integrated team powerful enough to help break the cycle of family violence.

Together with you, we are raising awareness and working toward a future free of family violence. Because of you, we can reach out to more families in need, and in the process give more children a reason to believe there is someone out there who cares. Join us in building a better, safer tomorrow for the families of our community. A selection of opportunities are provided in this packet.





Through an impressive combination of public and private resources, The Center for Family Safety and Healing fully addresses all aspects of family violence including child abuse and neglect, teen dating abuse, domestic violence and elder abuse. We offer a continuum of research-based prevention, intervention and treatment programs for individuals who have experienced family violence.

Benefits of this integrated team approach include:

- A one-stop, coordinated response to family violence for individuals and families through partnerships with law enforcement, child protection services, prosecution and a wide range of community resources
- Expanded forum for education, advocacy and ongoing research Programs and Services.

CHILD ASSESSMENT CENTER

The Child Assessment Center provides responsive and timely medical assessment and treatment along with interviews of children and family members who may have experienced child abuse or neglect. Children and adolescents are seen for comprehensive evaluations of alleged abuse or neglect.

FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAM

The Family Support Program, provided by Nationwide Children's Behavioral Health Services, offers counseling for children and adolescents who have been sexually or physically abused or exposed to family violence. Parent training is provided for families whose children are at risk for abuse or neglect.

HOME BASED TEAM

The Home Based Team, provided by Nationwide Children's Behavioral Health Services, offers intervention within the home and community setting utilizing evidence-based interventions to assist caregivers in developing a strong relationship with their child and learning healthy, effective discipline strategies.

ADULT SERVICES

We offer services to adult victims of family violence. Services include: office-based counseling, advocacy, linkage to additional community services and shelter care as needed.

FOSTERING CONNECTIONS PROGRAM

The Fostering Connections Program is a specialized foster care clinic offering comprehensive health care services to children and adolescents placed in out-of-home care.

HELP ME GROW

Help Me Grow provides home visitation to first-time, low income mothers from pregnancy through the child's third birthday. The program is designed to ensure children are healthy, safe and ready to learn.

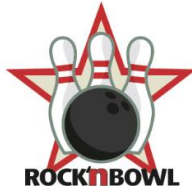
NURSE FAMILY PARTNERSHIP

Nurse Family Partnership (NFP) provides nurse home visitation to first-time, low-income mothers from early pregnancy through the child's second birthday. NFP improves pregnancy outcomes by encouraging preventive health practices that enhance child health outcomes.

TRAINING AND ADVOCACY

We offer customized family violence education and training for employers, faith-based organizations, healthcare systems, legal systems, schools/universities and other social service organizations.

Jeans Days

The Development Board also recommends hosting **Rock 'n Bowl Jeans Days** as another way to assist you in your fundraising efforts as well as build excitement leading up to the event. The main goal...breaking the cycle of family violence and restoring hope. Wearing jeans may lead to a more comfortable day in the office for you, but on Rock 'n Bowl Jeans Days it also generates hope for families relying on the services of a The Center for Family Safety and Healing.

What if we already wear jeans to work?

Rock 'n Bowl Jeans Days is more than just wearing jeans. It's also about supporting the Center for Family Safety and Healing in their continued efforts in addressing all aspects of family violence, including child abuse and neglect, teen dating abuse, domestic violence and elder abuse, thanks to an impressive combination of public and private resources. Consider wearing T-shirts with your jeans. Or, get creative and add another component by wearing your favorite team jersey, tennis shoes, or crazy hats instead.

What if we cannot wear jeans at the office?

Rock 'n Bowl Jeans Days are about supporting The Center for Family Safety and Healing at Nationwide Children's Hospital — in whatever way possible. Encourage employees to wear a certain color tie, shirt or blouse to support your efforts. Remember, these additional funds will go toward your overall Rock 'n Bowl team totals!

Can we raise funds in other ways?

Yes! All Rock 'n Bowl teams are encouraged to host additional fundraisers to support their overall team goals. Maybe it's a potluck lunch, office bake sale or team building lunches with Wii bowling tournaments where employees pay \$5 to participate. Be creative! How is the money collected? Where does it go?

Credit card donations may be made on a participant's fundraising page. Check and cash donations will be collected by team participants and submitted to Nationwide Children's Hospital at the Rock 'n Bowl event on Saturday, February 4. All proceeds from Rock 'n Bowl go to support the Center for Family Safety and Healing.

How much should our team charge for participation in Rock 'n Bowl Jeans Day?

We suggest \$5 or \$10 for each person participating but that is up to your team to decide. You know your company best and their level of participation.

When should I host our Jeans Day?

It's entirely up to you and your company/firm. We recognize that businesses have different schedules (especially during the upcoming holiday season) so we would love for you to host your own special day in support of Rock 'n Bowl anytime between now and February 3.
